



~ From Homewood at Frederick ~ Gail Slezak, Founder & Director



The Noteables Chorus of Homewood began in 2014 by new resident, Gail Slezak, who sought to form a chorus of independent living senior residents to enrich the community of Homewood with good choral music.

The repertoire for the most part is secular music, with genres of American music that the director, Gail, felt were not being heard and needed to be expressed in today's ever-changing world, lest we lose this wonderful musical heritage. Genres are American Folk, American Patriotic and Nostalgic Popular Music, with Inspirational Music added this year. At Christmastime, holiday music is performed. This 45-member chorus rehearses once a week in the Homewood at Frederick chapel.

In June, The Noteables once again sang the National Anthem at a Frederick Keys Baseball Game. Also within the chorus is a small group, The Madrigal Singers, who perform at various functions in the community.

Gail Slezak is a retired 30-year Frederick County Public Schools Choral Music Director from Catoclin High School. She also is a retired church choir director from the Frederick Church of the Brethren for more than 43 years. Gail currently resides at Homewood where she has directed the Noteables Chorus since May 2014.



Just like a choir, a worship service has many parts, and all of them must "harmonize" for the service to come together. Our featured chapel musician this month, Gail Slezak, knows all about this, as she has an extensive background in choral and vocal music, as well as piano. Gail plays on alternate fourth Sundays and, like our other musicians, helps pull the services together by providing "gathering music," accompaniment for singing the doxology and hymns, and postludes.



Gail began her musical career at age 3 as she danced and sang to her older sister's piano accompaniment. So that the audience could see her, she would often perform on a tabletop! Her sister gave her piano lessons, and Gail's love for music continued throughout her school years. She directed the chorus at her high school and even wrote the class song.

Gail majored in voice and minored in piano at Mt. Union College in Ohio, graduating "Magna Cum Laude" with her bachelor's degree in Music Education. While traveling through Frederick on her way back from a singing engagement, she liked it so much that she decided to stay. She applied for a teaching position and was hired by Frederick County Public Schools to teach vocal music in the fall of 1965.

Gail never left Frederick, teaching at the old Thurmont High and the new Catocin High School. Always interested in furthering her education, she took graduate courses at Peabody Conservatory, Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and the University of Maryland. In 1980, she took a sabbatical so that she could earn her Master of Liberal Arts degree and then taught until she retired.

While doing all this, Gail found time to serve as the chancel choir director at the Frederick Church of the Brethren for 43 years, which made her the church's longest-serving staff member. Gail also sang in the prestigious Washington Chorus for 20 years and performed with them at the Kennedy Center, Strathmore and Wolf Trap. In 2000, she was justifiably proud as the chorus won the Grammy Award for America's best choral music.

1. **Free Entry of Exhibits:** Catoctin High School gymnasium on Thursday, Sept. 4 from 5:30 - 8:30pm and on Friday, Sept. 5 from 8:30 - 11:30am. At registration, all exhibitors will be requested to provide a complete address and cell, home and/or work phone number(s) to prevent any delays in receiving premium checks or issues with any mailings which are returned. There will be reserved parking for exhibitors near the gym's entrance.
2. **Eligible Exhibitors:** Residents of Catoctin area feeder schools: Emmitsburg Elementary, Thurmont Primary, Thurmont Elementary, Thurmont Middle, Lewistown Elementary, Mother Seton School, Catoctin High School and Home-Schooled students. Sabillasville Environmental School (SES) students need to be a resident of the Catoctin area feeder schools listed or be a SES's Youth Agriculture Club member.
3. For each class, only one entry per person is allowed. All exhibits must be grown or made by the exhibitor. Please check under Dept. headings for potential additional rules.

The Dept. Supt. and/or the Community Show Committee has the final decision for which class an exhibitor's entry will be judged.

4. **All Baked Products** will be entered at Dept. 9 - Baked Products (Adults, Junior (Ages 10 & under) and Youth (Ages 11-18).
All Baked Products become the property of the Community Show Committee and will be auctioned at the Baked Goods Auction on Friday evening at 7:30pm in the auditorium. Any baked goods item deemed to be unsaleable for the baked goods auction is at the discretion of the judges and/or the Community Show committee.
5. No entry that has won in former years is eligible for a prize, excluding baked products. Eligible entries are non-perishable entries made since the Sept. 6-8, 2024 Community Show.
6. Dept. 22 - Junior Dept. is for Ages 10 & under. Dept. 23 - Youth Dept. is for Ages 11-18. All other Departments are "Open Class" except for Dept. 21 - Dairy Cattle, Dept. 21a - Dairy Goats, and the Youth Livestock Classes for Beef, Sheep, Swine and Market Goats.
7. For Dept. 12 - Fine Arts, ALL entries are required to be ready to hang for display purposes.

8. For ALL Photography entries, there are specific photo sizes and additional requirements: please see the rules for Dept. 14 - Photography, Dept. 22 - Junior Dept. and Dept. 23 - Youth Dept's photography classes.
9. This Community Show is being held under rules governed by and with the assistance of the Maryland Agricultural Fair Board, with approximately \$9,000 in premiums and ribbons to be won by exhibitors. Participation ribbons will be awarded in the Junior Dept only. Honorable mention ribbons will be awarded at the judge's discretion.
 - For each department, the judges will select a Dept. Champion and a Reserve Dept. Champion, which will be displayed on the Champion Table at the gym's center.
 - Each Dept. Champion will receive a \$10 Gift Certificate from Bollinger's Restaurant in Thurmont and each Reserve Dept. Champion will receive a \$5 gift certificate from Carleo Italian Pizza in Emmitsburg, which will be mailed by November 15, 2025.
10. The judge's placings will be accepted as final, and no nude or distasteful entries will be accepted. The Community Show Committee is not responsible in case of fire, theft, or accident, and reserves the right to pass on any decision not covered by these rules.
11. The Community Show is being hosted at Catoclin High School; therefore, Frederick County Public Schools (FCPS) policies govern this event. FCPS requirements with guidelines effective during this event will be posted here: www.fcps.org/uof
12. Removal of Exhibits: Exhibits may NOT be removed until Sunday, Sept. 7 starting at 3pm. All exhibits MUST be picked up on Sunday, Sept. 7 between 3-5:30pm. If you are unable to pick up your entries, please have a family member or friend pick them up for you. Any remaining entries may be picked up on Monday, Sept. 8 from 9am-Noon in the Ag Dept. at the back of the school.
13. Premium Checks will be mailed to all winners by Nov. 15, 2025 and will be void 60 days after the check's date. From the Community Show, each Dept. Champion will receive an additional \$5 premium and each Reserve Dept. Champion will receive an additional \$3 premium.





In 2004, the Ridenour Lamb was started in memory of Rebecka (Ruby) Ridenour. Rebecka loved showing her 4-H projects, the Community Show and helping youth with their projects.

Although Rebecka showed many species of animals, her favorite project was sheep – this is the reason the Ridenour Lamb award is given to the 3rd place sheep overall in the show. The recipient is given a pre-determined amount by Rebecka’s daughter, Ashley Ridenour Zimmerman, and all proceeds from the sale of the sheep go to the Ridenour Scholarship Fund.

The Ridenour Scholarship is annually awarded at the Catoctin FFA Chapter’s awards banquet. The scholarship is typically given to a student pursuing a nursing degree – to carry on Rebecka’s passion for nursing and caring for others.

Annual Beef, Sheep, Swine & Market Goat Sale

~ 1974-2024 ~



Calvin Saylor, a Catoctin area farmer and Hereford cattle breeder, lived on a farm in Rocky Ridge and was a member of the Catoctin FFA Alumni. He felt very strongly that the Thurmont & Emmitsburg Community Show should have a beef cattle sale.

On Sept. 13, 1974, the first beef cattle sale was held when seven 4-H, Grange and Catoctin FFA Alumni members exhibited nine cattle. Four of the seven are still living for the 50th Anniversary: Gwen Long Kuster, Patty Keilholtz Kerns, Mike Baust and Rodman Myers. Three additional exhibitors at the first livestock show & sale were Joe Wivell, Dallas McNair and Harry Swornley, who are now deceased.

Along with Thurmont High School's Vocational Agriculture teacher Bill Baker, Rodman Myers helped to start the Community Show 68 years ago. Bob Valentine, who was in the 9th grade at the time, was the master of ceremonies for the first Community Show program under Bill Baker's leadership. Bill Baker was the livestock sale's auctioneer for its first year, while Bob Valentine was the show's first year chair and served as chair for the next 49 years. Under Bob's leadership, both the show and sale expanded over the years with the addition of sheep, swine and goats. Both Rodman Myers and Bob Valentine have attended all the annual Community Shows over its 68-year history!

This annual event has been a highlight of the Thurmont & Emmitsburg Community Show – the largest community show in the State of Maryland.
